1.To implement COVID-19 protocols in the college.	Low risk patients: 1. No active COVID – 19 symptoms, RT -PCR negative. 2. COVID-19 patients in whom 14 days have elapsed after resolution of the symptoms and /or RT-PCR negative All dental procedures were undertaken with appropriate precautions for low risk patients. High risk patients: 1. Patients with COVID symptoms. 2. Patients with RT-PCR positive. High risk patients were referred to higher centres.

2.To overcome difficulties in pandemic

Fence barriers were placed to separate the general hospital from dental hospital.

Rotatory schedule was drafted for staff to attend the patients.

Sanitizers, N95 mask, PPE kit were provided to all the staff.

Staff treated only emergency cases and triage was carried out.

Public awareness banners and posters were placed inside and at the entrance of the college campus.

3.To provide dental treatment to the patients

Screening of patients:

Infrared thermometers were used to record body temperature .If positive, they were referred to General hospital for further management.

Patients were enquired about the history of any fever, cough, cold, breathlessness, recent visit to abroad, any contact with covid positive patients.

Patients were provided with face mask and strictly made them wear in the campus.

Kabasura kudineer was provided to everyone at the college reception.

Single common outpatient department was operated.

Disinfection of the dental chairs immediately after attending each patients.

Regulation fumigation was done.

4. To provide effective teaching and learning.

Online classes were taken through zoom app.

Regular assignments and test series were conducted and assessed through Google classroom.
